Rt Revd Robert Wickham BA MA | Bishop of Edmonton

Robert Wickham became the Bishop of Edmonton in September 2015. Since his ordination as a Deacon, Rob has always served in the Diocese of London. He was a Curate in the Parish Church of Willesden, a Team Vicar in the Parish of Old St Pancras, with a particular responsibility for St Mary's Somers Town, and then for nine years as Rector of St John at Hackney, latterly becoming Area Dean of Hackney.



Graham Miller | Chief Executive, London City Mission

"In October 2013, I joined London City Mission as the 15th Chief Executive. The city has never been more diverse or more needy, but I have great hope because Jesus is not a character from a historical fairy story. He is a Saviour who came for lost people, everywhere. I am pleased to be able to serve churches across London as they reach out to the poor, the elderly, the immigrants, and the marginalised who are so often neglected in our society."



Richard Coekin | Director, Co-Mission

Richard is a renowned Bible teacher and has been involved in launching numerous churches and other ministries, such as the London Mens' and Womens' Conventions, the 9:38 Ministry Training Strategy, the Passion for Life mission, and most recently The Planting Collective. He is also involved in a Bible ministry to Members of Parliament in Westminster.



Mike O'Neill | Chief Executive, Stewardship Services

Mike is the Chief Executive of Stewardship, which operates a donor advised fund for 35,000 clients in the United Kingdom, and professional services to over 1,000 churches and Christian charities. With income over £70m GBP they are one of the top 50 charities (top 10 faith-based) in England and Wales. A New York City native, Mike was formerly on the senior staff of NYC's Redeemer Church where he served as Executive Director of Hope for New York.



Richard Wells | Owner, Ethos Financial

Richard is the owner of Ethos Financial, helping many Mission Housing applicants with their mortgages over the last 6 years. He is also the franchise owner of Hunters Estate Agents in Catford, SE6; manager of Camberwell Fire (youth) Football Club; and a former missionary, IT contractor, council housing officer and charity worker. He has been part of The Well Community Church in Camberwell for the last 28 years, including 6 years on the leadership team.



Beth Grove | Pfander Centre for Apologetics

Beth Grove has worked with Muslims and studied Islam for over 20 years. For 17 years she co-led Hyde Park Christian Fellowship, an evangelistic team engaging Muslim Missionaries and Debaters at the infamous Speakers Corner, in London's Hyde Park. After running an English Language School for 6 years with her church, she co-founded and became the European Director of the Pfander Centre for Apologetics, a Christian research and teaching ministry that equips Christians to confidently engage Islam and Muslims with the gospel.



Jim Gilbourne | CEO, Mission Housing

Jim was appointed CEO of Affordable Christian Housing (ACH) in September 2011. When ACH transferred its engagements to Mission Housing in 2014, Jim became the first CEO of the merged organisation. Jim has over 25 years' senior management experience working within the mutual / charitable financial services sector.

Jim currently acts as Secretary for FICO (Fundraisers in Christian Organisations), which is a Special Interest Group of the Institute of Fundraising. Jim also serves as a trustee and treasurer of a homeless charity for young single people and ex-offenders in Kent (Pathways to Independence), and was also a trustee of the Friends Provident Foundation, a charity devoted to helping people and communities in the 'right use of money'.
